Acknowledge sin and embrace God's faithful forgiveness to restore fellowship. ☐ September 21 - Isaiah 55:6–7 a. Seek God earnestly, turning from wickedness to receive His mercy. ☐ September 22 - James 4:7–10 a. Pray for boldness in sharing the gospel and for church unity. ☐ September 29 - Acts 1:12–14 a. Emulate the early church's persistent prayer in anticipation of the Holy Spirit. ☐ September 30 - 1 Timothy 2:1–4 a. Intercede for all people, aligning with God's desire for salvation. ☐ October 1 - Psalm 86:11–12 a. Ask for an undivided heart to glorify God wholeheartedly. ☐ October 2 - 2 Chronicles 7:14 a. Embrace humility and prayer as conditions for God's healing and revival.
