Updated Guidelines (what we are currently doing)

Masks

 Attendees 4 and older who are unvaccinated should wear facemasks while in the church building. Outside of the building when social distancing can't be maintained facemasks should be worn. Masks must be worn properly, covering the nose and mouth at all times. (Parents should use their best judgement in putting face masks on children ages 2-3 while inside) Facemasks will be made available for those that need them.

Spacing

 While in the main worship gathering in the sanctuary spacing of 3-6ft should be maintained between family groups and will be encouraged by marking off every other row of pews. While in Sunday School and other classroom settings spacing of at least 3ft (1 chair space) between family groups should be maintained.

Meals and other Special Events

- Meals held inside should observe 6ft between family groups
- In the case of special events where social distance cannot be maintained, grace and unity should be of chief concern, thinking of others first. This could mean vaccinated attendees wearing masks in events when serving others food or communion or the washing of others feet.

Cleaning

• In addition to regular cleaning, building areas used for gathering will regularly have high touch surfaces cleaned. (tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, sinks) If more than one event is held in a day, areas should be disinfected between events.

Signs

 Required signage will be posted at exterior doors, sanctuary doors, and bathroom doors

Procedure for Positive COVID-19 Case or Contact

- If you have been attending in service and get COVID-19 or have confirmed contact with someone with COVID-19 please contact Pastor Scott or Board Chair. We will keep all information private unless you indicate otherwise.
- All congregants who were in attendance when the affected person was present will be notified by phone of possible exposure to a COVID-positive individual.
